We'd like to remind our residents school is back in session the roadways are actively being utilized by our students walking home. Please continue assist us during bus stop hours by using your turn signals during drop off/ pick up hours and obeying the bus stop parking area rules. Place a card or slip of paper in your child's backpack with a contact number in case of emergency, in any event that we may need to contact a parent or guardian.

We must be extremely vigilant. At the bus stop, we must remind our residents and guests when school buses are in operation and when students are getting on and off the school buses all vehicles are to remain parked until all the children have boarded or exited the school buses, we encourage all of our parents to utilize their cellphone video or dashcam videos to capture license plates and vehicle descriptions and forward them to the public safety department. You can remain anonymous upon identifying the vehicle, we could issue a citation to the violators. Public safety will also be on the lookout for aggressive drivers, speeding and stop sign violators on our roadways utilizing radar and video surveillance.
